Decision Concerning the Correction of Awards for Category "A" Claims

Pursuant to Article 41 of the Provisional Rules For Claims Procedure taken

by the Governing Council of the United Nations Compensation Commission at

its 81st meeting, held on 30 September 1998 at Geneva

The Governing Council,

<u>Having received</u>, in accordance with article 41 of the Provisional Rules For Claims Procedure (S/AC.26/1992/10) ("the Rules"), a report by the Executive Secretary covering 5 claims in category "A", $\frac{1}{2}$ /

1. <u>Decides</u>, pursuant to article 41 of the Rules, to correct the amounts of the approved awards for India for three claims from the fourth instalment, one claim from the fifth instalment, and one claim from the sixth instalment. $^2/$ The aggregate corrected amounts by claim instalment are as follows:

Instalment	Country	Previous total recommended award (US\$)	Corrected total recommended award (US\$)
Fourth	India	144,890,500.00	144,880,000.00
Fifth	India	145,465,000.00	145,461,000.00
Sixth	India	17,433,500.00	17,429,500.00

2. <u>Directs</u> the Executive Secretary to effect the above corrections and to provide copies of the tables containing the breakdown of the amounts to be paid to the affected individual claimants to the Government of India.
